- People ask us what we speak about, and we are usually asked to talk about global matters and kingdom expansion. We speak on "What in the world is God Doing?" or "Don't Miss the Explosion." Yes, we focus on Christ's mission to reach the world by multiplying outward focused leaders, who have unimaginable needs, voracious passion for Christ, and pulsating potential.



- **GTN ANNUAL RETREAT: A SUMMER HIGHLIGHT.** We finished out the month at the GTN Retreat (our mother partner) in Sumas, Washington. It was a fantastic time to gather with our GTN teammates and hear stories of God's amazing work worldwide. Paul Madson, the founder of GTN, powerfully shared his heart and passion for GTN. NEW G-ANGeL OPPORTUNITIES



God is opening more and more doors in countries who are crying out for leadership equipping and training to reach their nations for Christ.

- Our goal from the beginning has been to expand G-ANGeL to 50 countries. However, we never intended to fulfill the goal ourselves. We have always planned to train and equip others to follow the Holy Spirit's leading to countries they are passionate about reaching and equipping leaders.
- In July and August we received six new requests from churches and GTN trainers to be trained by the Academy (G-ANGeL) in 2011. All of these leaders and leadership teams are involved in multiple countries and /or have potential to impact many more.



- PLEASE PRAY for these six new opportunities of leaders and leadership teams to expand God's Kingdom through G-ANGeL into multiple countries.

FALL PLANS

- RETURN TO CAMBODIA IN OCTOBER. We will return to Phnom Penh, home of the "Killing Fields", to train 300 young pastors and wives. We will be joining Joel Madson, good friend and GTN VP for the second year. Many of their elders, parents and relatives were brutally murdered by Pol Pot and his "henchmen", yet they have dreams, vision and hope as they plant churches to fulfill the Great Commandment and the Great Commission.
- Do pray for God's preparation for us and the young Cambodian leaders to see leadership multiplication expand Christ's Kingdom. Cambodia is still 95% Buddhist, though the gospel is growing there amidst daily oppression and resistance.
- Pray for the women's version of the Academy. Like many countries, they are just learning the value of training their women leaders. Pray for Patricia as last minute arrangements for the women are made. There are ALWAYS last minute adjustments!
- INDIA POSTPONED UNTIL 2011. The coordinator's and women's leadership conferences have been postponed due to the Commonwealth Games, and threats by the Taliban and Al Qaeda to blow them up. We are working on the spring of 2011.
- BRAZIL RESCHEDULED. Our September trip has been rescheduled to November. Phil Warkentien, friend, missionary and translator extraordinaire has had heart issues. Please pray for God's timing and planning.

- CONFERENCES AVERAGE BETWEEN \$5,000-\$15,000.

The average is \$7,000. It costs \$15-\$25 per day for a pastor, or \$50 for a three day conference, and \$100 per couple.

For example:

\$500 sponsors 10-15 pastors,
\$1,000 sponsors 20-30 pastors,
\$5,000 sponsors 100-150 pastors.
